PAINTING TIPS

hat a home would be without the touch of colours? Freshen up your new home sweet home to rejuvenate your inner calm spirit. Painting a room or a house can be a task that takes a couple of hours, a half-day, or more. But it all depends on what and how much you decide to paint. In this issue, "Seri Alam will share a few techniques and tips on how to paint your house like a pro.



Brush or roller

Both tools are easy to use in a painting job. To paint using brush with beveled bristles, paint five or six strokes perpendicular to the edge of the ceiling or the wall for a smooth finish. If you choose to use a roller, begin by making an M, a backward N, or a W pattern about 3 feet square.

Tint the primer 6

A coat of primer is key to obtaining professional-looking results. The primer serves three main functions: First, it blocks stains and resinous knots from bleeding through; second, it provides one-coat coverage for the paint topcoat; most importantly, it improves adhesion, which greatly reduces blisters and extends the life of the topcoat.



Canvas drop cloths are durable, and rip- and puncture-resistant. They lay flat as you walk across them, presenting less of a tripping hazard. Canvas also absorbs paint drips, unlike plastic drop cloths that become slippery when spattered with wet paint. Plus, canvas can be reused countless times.



Use paint grid

Use a paint grid instead of a paint tray. Hang the grid in the paint bucket. Dip half of the roller sleeve into the paint, and roll it against the grid to remove excess paint, which drips back into the bucket. At the end of the day, just drop the grid into the bucket and snap on the lid.



Record the colour

Before replacing the light-switch covers and electrical-outlet covers in a newly painted room, write down the vital information (brand name, paint color, paint number) onto a piece of masking tape and stick it to the back of a switch plate. And there it'll stay until it's time to repaint, when you'll discover it.



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Congenital Heart Disease in Children (part 2)

Treatment and care

Treatment is based on the severity of the d's heart condition. Some mild heart refects do not require any treatment. Others can be treated with medications, interventional procedures or surgery.

1. Procedures using catheters

This procedure allows the repair to be done without surgically opening the chest and heart. The doctor inserts a thin tube into a vein in the leg and guides it to the heart with the help of an X-ray. Once the catheter is positioned, tiny tools are threaded through the catheter to repair the defect.

2. Open heart surgery

The surgery involves opening the chest and going on a cardiopulmonary bypass. These surgeries may be major and complex and recovery depends on the type of surgery performed.

Some congenital heart defects can be treated with medications that help the heart work more efficiently.

Some children may require multiple procedures and surgeries throughout their life. Although the outcomes for children with heart defects have improved dramatically, some still require ongoing care even after corrective surgeries.

Prevention

The exact cause of most congenital heart defects is unknown. However there are some things that one can do to reduce the child's overall risk of birth defects:

- Get Rubella vaccine.
- Control chronic medical conditions, diabetes must be well controlled before pregnancy.
- Avoid taking any medications, unnecessary herbs.








then & now

y earliest recollection of the township was when it was known as Han Yang Estate owned then by Chee Tat Plantations Sdn Bhd (now known as Seri Alam Properties Sdn Bhd). It was twenty seven years ago (1986) when I first stepped onto the estate to attend a job interview as a typist clerk. Thinking back, it was a very bumpy ride passing through the laterite road with oil-palm trees lining both sides and I can still sense the eeriness from journeying under the shades.

As I drove home from work yesterday, I recall the early days of BSA and am amazed with the changes and a sformation of this township. From just a single laterite at through the oil palm and rubber plantation, the township is now interconnected with dual carriage ways, intersections, bridges and flyovers that have criss-crossed the entire area.

Having mentioned the laterite road, it also brings to mind the dry season on this road. Every time a heavy vehicle (lorries or tractors) drove by, you would have a whoosh of powdery dust blown onto you. I remember the sides of the road which had cash crops growing on the ground of the plantation, being blanketed with the dust residue, where the colour of the crop would turn from green to a clay yellow.

My memories also go back to the time when during one of the rainy seasons, the access to the estate was

flooded, making it impassable. The neighbouring granite company assisted in transporting people & motor cycles using very gigantic excavators. Some ten to fifteen people and a motor-bike or two would be in the mouth of the excavator, which would then be driven through the flood waters to higher or drier ground. These excavators were very huge, with tyres taller than the average man, that even the waist high flood, barely touched these tyres.

The rainy season would also cause the water to be very murky, due to the muddy rainwater from all over would drain into the catchment ponds. Thus would arise the shortage of good clean water. In fact my brothers would joke about this saying we got "draft teh susu" straight from the tap as the water would be the exact replica of milk tea.

"Drafts" like these were when the tankers would cart water to the staff quarters to supply the daily ration to the households. It was during this times that my late mother (God rest her soul) would collect the rain water in drums using a muslin filter. I must say I have probably never seen such crystal clear, cold natural water ever in my life other than from taps. Rain water collected in this manner would mostly be used to water plants, wash the outside of the house and for other ablutions but never for consumption and in cooking. Nowadays the township has an uninterrupted

supply of clean (SAJ) water distribution to every household.

As I reminisce about the past, the early mornings were always the best time of the day. You open the front door to the fragrance of rose perfumes that eke out of the rose bushes that lined the front of the house. And a close up of the rose flowers and leaves would reveal drops of dew from the night before. The kaleidoscope of colours before me was magical. There were bright fuchsia pink bougainvilleas, egg yellow alamandas, pink and white petunias and the stark orange or red and purple on the birds of paradise. Presently, as I drive through the township that is BANDAR SERI ALAM, there are well landscaped townparks, roads with their tall palm or pine trees on the road dividers, well manicured hedges and tree lined roads along "The Valley" which make me feel that this township has retained the splendor of the "GREEN" theme in its development.

With the passing of nostalgia,... the 'duststorms', floodwaters, thrilling rides and greenery, I am very grateful to the life that I experienced *then* and even more for the great living that I am having *now*.
